DRIVING LICENSE

When buying a car in the Netherlands, you will need a valid driving license. Either a Dutch driving license or a Foreign one. Here are the differences.

✔ Dutch driving license

If you already have a Dutch driving license, we can register the car on your name at your home address when Bynco delivers the car.

✔ Foreign driving license

If you have a foreign driving license, the car needs to be registered on your name by the RDW. Bynco will be there to assist you, but you will need to bring along additional documents;

- a) A Valid foreign driving license
- b) An original (not a copy) certificate registration in the Netherlands (BRP- extract (including BSN), not older than 3 months).

INSURANCE

At the moment the car is registered on your name, the car needs to be insured by you. For this, you will need a 4-digit code called, "meldcode". You will receive this after purchasing a car from Bynco.

In the Netherlands, you can compare insurance companies and choose an insurance that fits you best. You can, for instance, use the comparison tool by [PriceWise](#) for this.
